



## CALL FOR PAPERS

The topic of the 6<sup>th</sup> edition of the *Meetings for the Study of the Alpine Traditions* (I.S.T.A.) is «**Memento mori. Rituals, image and collective imagination of death in the Alps**».

The theme has the aim of studying the concept of death in the Alpine area through a multidisciplinary approach that includes literary aspects, archival sources, archaeological evidence, artistic or ethno-anthropological research.

It is allowed to submit an abstract of a paper according to the following guidelines:

- Focus on a single place or a valley in the Alps;
- Social aspects related to death (burials, processions, mourning, confraternities...);
- Artistic aspects related to death (representations, objects, *ex voto*, decorations ...);
- Beliefs and traditions associated with death in the literature or in the present (case studies).

Organizations, associations, museums, universities, researchers or subject-matter experts are invited to send an abstract of the paper by the **31<sup>st</sup> May 2016**.

The Organizing Committee will communicate the results of the abstracts selection by **30<sup>th</sup> June 2016**.

Selected candidates must deliver the paper by the **30<sup>th</sup> November 2016**.

The papers considered suitable by the Committee will be inserted in a book published in the **2017**.

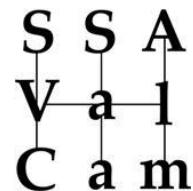
