



Società Storica e Antropologica di Valle Camonica (*Valle Camonica Historical and Anthropological Society*) organizes for the **13th October 2018** in Breno (BS-Italy) the eighth edition of *Incontri per lo Studio delle Tradizioni Alpine (Meetings for the Study of Alpine Traditions)*.

The theme of this year is «**Rising borders in the Alps: drawing, deleting, remaking**».

Following the conference, the organization will publish a volume containing both reports presented during the conference, and other texts selected through this call for papers.

Call for papers

The call aims to gather and select papers later collected in a volume that will focus -similarly to the conference - on case studies linked to specific issues regarding Alpine borders.

The applicants should submit papers making use of literary, archival, historical, artistic sources and ethno-anthropological researches.

Guidelines

The applicants should submit an abstract of their paper by **June 17th 2018**, to the email address **contactista@gmail.com** adhering to the following guidelines.

The allowed languages are Italian and English.

The abstract should have a maximum length of 2.000 strokes with the following information:

- First Name, Surname, affiliation, phone number and email address of the author/authors;
- Essential Bibliography regarding the proposed subject (max. three titles).

Guidelines for the contributions

- Overview of a single case study, regarding a physical or political border inside the Alpine region;
- Time period: from the Middle Ages up to today;
- Description of the landmarks seen as border;
- Political, religious, cultural and identity aspects of the border;
- Fights, conflicts and disputes related to the case study;
- Treaties, deeds, documents and other legal sources;
- Perception and interpretation of the border by the local communities;
- The physical and social changes caused by the border.

Selection

The organisation will announce the selected abstracts by **June 30th, 2018**.

The accepted applicants must present their papers by **December 15th, 2018**.

Some of the abstracts submitted may be **selected to be presented** during the conference.

The organisation could, at its own discretion, accept, deny or require revision for any abstract and/or paper to be published.
