



Valle Camonica Historical and Anthropological Society is organizing the ninth edition of the *Meetings for the Alpine Tradition Study* (I.S.T.A.) on 12th October 2019 in Breno (BS-Italy). The topic of the meeting will be «**Witchcraft in the Alps. Curses, trials, inquisitors and stakes**».

Following the conference, the organization intends to publish a volume which will contain both the papers presented at the meeting and those selected through this Call for papers.

Call for papers

The Call for Papers intends to collect and select articles to be included in a volume that will deal, with an interdisciplinary look, with cases study related to manifestations of witchcraft (defined as an accusation of alleged magic activity to the detriment of other people for private or ritual purposes) in the Alpine area from the medieval to the contemporary age. Participation is free of charge.

The candidates are invited to submit an abstract of their paper according to the following indications:

Abstract of the paper	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Maximum length of 2,000 characters, spaces included. • Name, surname, affiliation (e.g. with a university or research institution), telephone number and email address of the author or authors. • Bibliography consulted about the proposed topic (maximum three titles).
Guidelines	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Examination of a single ,coherent and well-defined case (e.g. a single character or a series of chronologically related events) that occurred in the Alpine area. • Geographical, historical, political, religious, cultural framework of the case study. • Period: from the medieval to the contemporary age. • Precise references to sources, archives, testimonials, databases. • Artistic, literary, poetic, legendary and traditional studies related to the case study can be included in the analysis.
